## **RED HUGHS SINCE 1981**

It is with great pleasure that today the Red Hughs Club competes in the final of the Senior Championship. Although the club has only been in existence six years since its re-formation in 1981. It has had the honour of competing in many finals in that time, but until now success in this particular competition has always eluded us.

Although only in its first year of competition, it was with little surprise for many people that 1981 was such a successful year, as many of the players were former members of the players were former members of the Robert Emmets club: In that year we had the honour of winning the Junior Championship and the Division III League as well as finishing runners-up in the Division II Shield.

1982 saw the club reach the Intermediate final only to lose narrowly to Urris, as well as gain promotion to Division I behind Downings.

In 1983 the club found itself in both Division I of the Senior Championship, a great achievement after only two years. Although success was to pass us by that year the club was pleased with its overall performance in the League's top Division.



SEAN IRWIN (Red Hughs) 1984 saw a downward turn in\_ the club's fortunes, after struggling for most of the year, it was with disappointment that the club were relegated to Division II and knocked out of the Senior Championship in the first round.

However, 1985 saw the club bounce back and after a good League campaign campaign were narrowly pipped for promotion back to Division I, and also for the first time reached the quarterfinals of the Senior Championship.

The 1986 season saw the club off to a successful start with victory over neighbours, Robert Emmets in the Division II Shield final, and as lately as last Sunday saw the club win the Second Division title in Gweedore.

Today, we hope to conclude a magnificent season by winning the Senior Championship and achieve a unique year by bringing both the Senior football and Hurling championships to Killygordon.

A special welcome today to Mr. Paddy Hannigan, Killygordon, who is in his 93rd year. Paddy is the oldest Senior footballer living in Donegal and a member of the old Red Hughs championship teams of the '20s.

#### FOUNDING OF AODH RUADH G.A.A. CLUB

Following a public meeting in 1909 and inspired by a call by the local branch of the Gaelic League, "to consider the advisability of having some Irish games started in the town", the Aodh Ruadh G.A.A. Club was founded at a meeting held on Sunday, October 24th, 1909. At the meeting the admission fee to the games was fixed at one shilling and a membership fee of one penny per week was levied. The first hurling and football practices by the new club took place in the 'Workhouse Meadow' now known as Munday's Field at West Rock on Sunday, October 31st, 1909. Capitalising on the local talent available and particularly on an established hurling tradition the club since its foundation has met with significant success in both hurling and football competitions. The holder of county hurling championships at both senior and under age level, Aodh Ruadh can count the following among its successes on the football fields:

- Val Murray: Forward. 18 years. 6'. 11 st. Student. Brother of Brian and Alan. Has come through the Aodh Ruadh under-age ranks and has been starring for the Junior team for the past two years. Won U-21 medal in 1985 with Aodh Ruadh. Has played for Donegal U-16s and U-18s.
- Paschal McTiernan: Forward. 24 years. 6' 1". 12 st. Painter. Came back from New York where he played for Donegal and trained very hard to win back his place on the Senior team. Now a full forward after playing for many years at full back. Won U-12, U-16, U-18, and U-21 medals with Aodh Ruadh and Ulster and All-Ireland Colleges medals with DLS Ballyshannon. Played for several years with Claremorris, Co. Mayo. Has represented Donegal at U-18 and U-21 levels and also played for Donegal Vocational Schools.
- Pauric Daly: Forward. 28 years. 5' 9". 12 st. Teacher. Experienced forward who is still looking for his first ever Championship medal with Aodh Ruadh. A son of the late Hugh Daly he is the present secretary of Cumann na mBunscoill. Holds Dalton Cup medal won with DLS Ballyshannon. Brother of Tom.
- P. J. Buggy: Team Manger. Civil Servant. Was previously manager from 1981 to 1983. Led U-21s to County Championship in 1981 and 1982. Very involved in Aodh Raudh's Bord na nÓg and is present chairman. Was assistant manager to Pat Conaghan's Ulster Minor League winning side in 1984 and Jimmy White's Minor League and Ulster Championship winning team in 1985. Is present Co. Minor Board Secretary, Holds Minor Football and Minor and Senior Hurling medals won with Aodh Ruadh.
