Draws made for Football Championships

THE football draws at the adjourned convention were held last Friday night in Timahoe, with a number of mouth-watering prospects on the calendar for the start of the various championships.

The one that does stand out is in the U-21 FC, where the 1994 surprise champions, Crettyard, take on the 1994 finalists, Portarlington.

Also, County Champions St Josephs will have a tough passage if they hope to reach the knockout stages, with Stradbally, Portlaoise, Spink and Timahoe also in their group.

The Harps, playing in their first year in the senior football championships, will compete for a knock out place with Emo, O'Dempseys, Annanough and the previous Intermediate champions, Killeshin.

But the real battle will take place in Group C, where four of the eight quarter finalists of last year are drawn together, and with Crettyard also on a high after there U-21 success, this should be a cracker of a group.

LAOIS u-21's TO DEFEND TITLE


LAOIS u-21 footballers will after all defend their Provincial title. Sincere gratitude is expressed to the members of the Leinster
