







A Gaoin Doblian man ar

Martin Coll (22) from Middletown in Derrybeg will play only his second National Football League game for Donegal today at Ballybofey.

The third eldest in a family of four, he is a son of Freddie and Helena Coll and according to his mother "he has been playing football for as long as she can remember."

Naturally, Martin's parents and three sisters, Dara, Bridgena and Treásá are delighted with Martin's progression to the senior ranks, but they are joined by a large body of people - perhaps an older generation - who still believe a Donegal team is incomplete without a Gaoth Dobhair man.

Martin takes up the mantle for the Gaoth Dobhair club from Donal 'Dods' Breslin, their most recent county player, but there have been some household names from the Gaoth Dobhair club who have played for the county over the years - among them Anton Carroll, Neilly Gallagher, Hughie Tim Boyle, the Coyles, Hudai Beag Gallagher (who was on the first Ulster team to win a Railway Cup in 1942).

Interestingly there was a P. Coll from Gaoth Dobhair who played for Donegal in 1937, all of which augurs well for Martin.

But Martin has been making his own headlines too. Speaking to him on Thursday he mentioned with some pride that he had an U-21 county championship medal with Gaoth Dobhair and there are other juvenile honours, with the exception of a club minor medal - a medal I think he's disappointed not to have.

Big and strong, Martin came to the notice of John Joe O'Shea when he played for Pobalscoil Gaoth Dobhair and was selected by him at full-back for the 1992 Vocational School team which won the Ulster title that year, going down to Kerry in Ballinasloe, Martin moving to centre-half back for the injured Damien Diver.

A little later in the year Sean Ward placed him at centre-half back for the minor team, Donegal losing the Ulster final to Armagh.

In 1994 P. J. McGowan, in his final year as Under-21 team manager, selected Martin to play at centre-back against Fermanagh in Irvinestown but Donegal were beaten by the Erne county who went on to win the Ulster title.

A year later Martin was back again for the Ú-21s, this time under a new boss, Donal Reid, who brought him in as a sub at semi-final stage against Fermanagh. Coll almost immediately conjured up the vital pass which led to an equally vital Brian

Roper goal.

Not surprisingly, he started the final, Donegal against Cavan - Martin McHugh against Donal Reid in management terms. Donegal were happy with a draw, Coll starting at centre-half forward and moving to midfield. For the replay Martin was started at midfield and he had a towering afternoon - his best ever game in a county jersey, Donegal winning, Martin scoring two points.

When Donegal went down to Kerry at semi-final stage, Martin received a letter from now senior manager, P. J. McGowan, inviting him to join the county panel.

"That was September 1995 and I have been with them ever since but a groin injury has curtailed my involvement until now, explained Martin. He played in a number of challenge games - against Mayo and Leitrim and then got his big chance, playing in November '95 against Kerry in the NFL.

Donegal lost that one but Coll didn't lose

heart. He didn't get a second chance until today to prove his worth and now he tells me he's "fully fit and looking forward to

the game."

Martin, who works with Bio Medical Research in Gaoth Dobhair - a company who provide equipment often used by injured players, says he's "happy to get the chance to play for the county" and it's a sentiment that will echo around the county as a Gaoth Dobhair man, a native Irish speaker, lines out at midfield for Tir Chonaill.

Valid points from top marksman

The call this week by county chairman, Danny McNamee, for the association in Donegal to hold a serious discussion into the running of domestic competitions has been backed by Manus Boyle.

Manus, who chalked up 4-54 in Killybegs' nine championship games in Donegal - he scored seven points against St. Paul's in the Ulster Club Championship tie in Ballyshannon - is the only player from his club in today's starting line-up.

And while he's looking forward to today's league opener, he openly admits that 1996 has been the most demanding years he has encountered since Killybegs won the championship back in 1988.

"It's been hectic. We started training for the club championship back in May after Donegal lost to Cavan, and we were still going into October. I think it's time that the fixtures situation is looked at. Otherwise, Donegal football is going to be the loser," he says.

With so many hard months of training and tough games behind him, Manus has already commenced a "semi-break," and plans to train very little between now and Christmas.

"Regardless of what you're involved in, you need to take time out. To have the appetite back for the championship next year, it's important to take a break," he stresses.

"In the end, a season without some sort of break is senseless," he adds.

The free-scoring forward, whose contribution of nine points in the All-

Ireland final of 1992 will never be forgotten, maintains that league games should go ahead during the summer.

"Unless the senior team reaches the Ulster Final, I believe that all games should be played. Players need games to keep them sharp, and if the league programme was kept at the start of the season, I don't think there would be such a pile up at this time of year," he states.

According to the 30 year old, some of the players from 1992 are still suffering from burn-out. While the same success has not been achieved, their schedule, if anything, has become even more demanding.
