

- 03. The consumption of alcohol is not permitted within the ground and spectators are not permitted to bring alcohol into the ground.
- 04. The unauthorized climbing of any structure, walls or buildings in this ground strictly forbidden.
- 05 Unnecessary noise from the use of radio sets, gas-horns and behavior likely to cause confusion Of nuisance of any kind, including foul or abusive language, is not permitted in any part of the ground.
- 06. Under no circumstances is it permitted to throw any object the pitch.

- 07. Unauthorised persons are not permitted to enter upon the field of play.
- 08. Any person who fails to comply with the instruction from a Garda or Steward may be ejected from the

# 1985 Donegal County Minor Championship final Killybegs hold on to retain title

The Donegal Democrat report of the 1985 Donegal minor championship final records that Killybegs retained their minor crown but only after Aodh Ruadh squandered many chances in both halves.

The final was played in Fr. Tierney Park, Ballyshannon, and Killybegs led at half-time by 2-2 to 1-4, thanks to two goals in quick succession midway through the half from Conal 'Flipper' Gallagher.

Aodh Ruadh had plenty of possession but were unable to take advantage while Killybegs (who were also the reigning Ulster Minor club champions) used their possession to the maximum.

Aodh Ruadh got the best possible start with a goal from Thomas O'Brien inside 30 seconds and they were denied a second goal when O'Brien came in along the endline to cross for Eunan Walsh to finish to the net but O'Brien was adjudged to have stepped over the endline.

Martin Murchan got Killybegs on the scoreboard while John Forkin replied for Aodh Ruadh. But then came the double salvo from Conal Gallagher. Points from Diarmaid Keon and Val Murray left just a point in it at the break.

The second half saw Killybegs retain their advantage but as in the first half, Aodh Ruadh had plenty of chances but just couldn't avail of them and the Fishermen held out for the one point win.

Both sides finished with 14 men with Martin Murchan and Philip McCarthy being sent off.

### Did you Know?

The name Cloich Cheann Fhaola (also written Cloich Chionnaola, meaning "the Stone of Faoil's Head") comes from a story which tells of the killing of Faoil. The story says that Balor of the Evil Eye beheaded Faoil on a rock because Faoil stole the Cow of Plenty from Balor and brought it back to the mainland from Tory

The name Falcarragh (lit. An (the) Fál (Wall) Carrach (Stone), Stone Wall / Boundary) has been used since 1850, ascribed so by O' Donavan as he believed 'Na Crois Bhealaf', the Cross Roads, was too common in Ireland to allow distinction. Na Crois Bhealaf is still used by native speakers when referring to the town. On some maps it shows up as 'Crossroads' deriving from its Irish language name Na Croisbhealaf but older maps refer to it as Robinson's Town, but its now listed as An Fál Carrach. An Fál Carrach, the main commercial town between Letterkenny and Dungloe was known in former times both as Crossroads and as Robinson's Town. An Fál Carrach, the official name, originally referred to a little hamlet south east of the present town, at the foot of Falcarragh hill - but gradually houses were built at the crossroads, mainly for the workers and trades people employed on the Olphert Estate in Ballyconnell.

The first recorded reference to Falcarragh appears in a report written by William Wilson, who was the Protestant Bishop's stewart responsible for the collection of tithes to support the Protestant clergy. He, apparently, received a hostile reception on arrival in Cloughaneely (parish) according to his account to the bishop: According to my intention I went to Cloughineely and on Monday about 12 o'clock arrived at a place called Falcarrow in your Lordship's See (about five miles distant from Dunfanaghy) where I then, pursuant to advertisement, proposed holding the Court as I twice before had, but was immediately on my arrival surrounded by upwards of 150 to 300 men who had assembled merely for the purpose of preventing me from holding any Court and threatened my life if I would.

From 1622 to 1921, the Olpherts were the main landlords in the district, Sir John Olphert being the last Olphert landlord, who died in 1917.

The tallest Celtic cross in Ireland is located near Falcarragh. Falcarragh railway station opened on 9 March 1903, closed for passenger traffic on 3 June 1940 and finally closed altogether on 6 January 1947

### **Centre of Excellence**

The need for a centre of excellence and the finding of a suitable location has engaged the GAA in Donegal for a number of years. Once a positive decision was taken to develop a centre the search then began to find a suitable site. In 2008 a suitable 26 acres site was located near Convoy. Allan & Curran Architects Ltd, Donegal Town, were engaged to seek planning and permission was granted in 2010 for five pitches, handball court and hurling wall and clubhouse.

A contract was awarded in July to Curran Contracts, Armagh, to develop two sand carpeted floodlit pitches with other essential site works and planning requirements. The contractors were quickly on site and achieved a lot of work in short period of time until the intervention of the 'monsoon period'. The vast majority of the heavy earth moving cut & fill has been completed and the bases for the two pitches are ready and pitch drainage will commence once weather conditions are suitable. Pitches will be ready for use by the Summer of 2012.

During the works three bronze age cooking sites (500 to 1500 B.C.) were unearthed and this created some excitement in the area. The Department of the Environment gave permission to preserve the sites in situ and this has been done.

The next stage in the development will be erection of clubhouse etc to be ready for use by the Summer of 2012. As funding allows later stages will include a full size 3 g floodlit pitch, two more sand carpeted pitches, hurling wall and handball court.
